It can take as little as 5 minutes to publish on Kindle. If you're ready, that is.

1 MAKE A MOBI FILE

First, format your book as a MOBI file. (This is the ebook format for Kindle.)

You can hire an ebook developer to do this manually, or, use [Pressbooks.com](#) to convert your book file for \$19.99.

3 DECIDE ON EXCLUSIVITY

Decide whether or not you want to enroll in KDP Select.

KDP Select gives you the ability to run promotions and special offers on your book. It also makes your book available in the Kindle Owners Lending Library and to Kindle Unlimited subscribers. In return for exclusivity (for a 90-day term).

5 UPLOAD YOUR EBOOK FILE

Upload the MOBI file you made at [Pressbooks](#) or coded manually.

While it is now possible to upload other types of files into the Kindle store, a well-formatted MOBI file (such as the kind generated at [Pressbooks.com](#)) has the best chance of rendering elegantly across all the different Kindle devices.

2 SIGN UP AT KDP

Create an account at Kindle Direct Publishing.

Have your banking information and tax id handy, as Amazon will need these to report and credit your royalties.

4 ADD BOOK METADATA

Enter your book's metadata to maximize its discoverability in the Kindle store.

Metadata refers to your book's title, description, keywords, etc. If you used [Pressbooks](#), you'll find this on your Book Info screen. Sculpt your words carefully to optimize your book's discoverability to potential readers.

6 UPLOAD YOUR EBOOK COVER

Your cover will be inside your book file, but you will also upload it separately.

The cover should be in a 1.6 height/width ratio, no less than 1000 x 625 pixels. The file should take up less than 50 MB and be produced in RGB (Web colors). Click for some of our tips on how to get a book cover made.

7 SPECIFY YOUR RIGHTS

Tell Kindle which countries and territories you would like to distribute your book to.

8 SET YOUR PRICING

What's the best price for your ebook? Research by [Smashwords](#) suggests a literal answer: \$3.99. But there are many complex factors to consider. At what price point will readers take a chance on a book they haven't heard of? Or make an impulse buy? How much did you invest in producing your book and need to recoup?

9 CHOOSE YOUR ROYALTY OPTION

You can choose a 35% royalty for books priced between \$.99 and \$200 (the minimum price varies slightly based on the size of your book file in MB). Or, you can opt for a 70% royalty for books priced between \$2.99 and \$9.99.

10 CLICK SAVE AND PUBLISH

Congratulations, you're finished uploading your book to the Kindle store. Now, it's time to get started writing your next one!
