

## Chart of Common Imperatives

To form the imperative in Greek, add the following endings to the appropriate tense stem. (For 1st Aorists, change the -σα ending of the indicative to -σον or -σαι). Remember that aorist imperatives receive no augment.

### 2nd Person

<b>Active</b>	Singular	Plural
Present/2nd Aorist	+ ε	+ τε
1st Aorist	+ σον	+ τε

<b>Middle</b>	Singular	Plural
Present/2nd Aorist	+ σο (ου)	+ σθε
1st Aorist	+ σαι	+ σθε

παύω, παύσω, ἔπαυσα (1st aorist)  
λείπω, λείψω, ἔλιπον (2nd aorist)

<b>Active</b>	Singular	Plural
Present/2nd Aorist	παῦε/λίπε	παύετε/λίπετε
1st Aorist	παῦσον	παύσατε

παύω, παύσω, ἔπαυσα (1st aorist)  
δέχομαι δέξομαι ἔδεξάμην (1st aorist)

<b>Middle</b>	Singular	Plural
Present	παύου/δέχου	παύεσθε/δέχεσθε
1st Aorist	παῦσαι/δέξαι	παύσασθε/δέξασθε
